

**Translation of letter from UTTARAKHAND STATE GOVERNMENT regarding reservation of seats for
Uttarakhand domicile students in Private Universities in Uttarakhand State.**

Subject: Facilities to be provided to permanent residents of Uttarakhand by the Private Universities.

In respect of the subject matter, it is to inform that after examining various proposals received by the State Administration to establish private universities and for the existing private universities, following points are proposed to be incorporated in the interest of the State:

1. For admissions, 15% seats in the programs being run by the University shall be reserved for the permanent residents of the State.
2. A concession of 26% of the prescribed fee shall be granted to the permanent residents of the State.
3. All the positions in Group C and D shall be filled in by the permanent residents of the State.
4. The permanent residents of the State shall be given preference in appointments in academic positions.

Therefore, in the interest of the State I have been directed to seek your consent on all the above said points at the earliest.

विषय : निजी विश्वविद्यालयों द्वारा राज्य के स्थायी निवासियों को अतिरिक्त सुविधाएं उपलब्ध कराए जाने के सम्बन्ध में ।

महोदय,

उपरोक्त विषयक अवगत कराना है, कि राज्य में स्थापित निजी विश्वविद्यालयों एवं निजी विश्वविद्यालयों की स्थापना हेतु शासन को प्राप्त प्रस्तावों का शासन स्तर पर परीक्षणोपरांत राज्य हित में निम्न बिन्दुओं का समावेश किया जाना प्रस्तावित है :-

- (1) संघलित पाठ्यक्रमों में प्रवेश हेतु 15 प्रतिशत स्थान राज्य के स्थायी निवासियों के लिए आरक्षित किये जायेंगे ।
- (2) निर्धारित शुल्क में 26 प्रतिशत की छूट राज्य के स्थायी निवासियों को प्रदान की जायेगी ।
- (3) श्रेणियों "ग" एवं "घ" के सभी पदों पर शत-प्रतिशत नियुक्ति राज्य के स्थायी निवासियों को प्रदान की जायेगी ।
- (4) शैक्षणिक स्टाफ की नियुक्ति में राज्य के स्थायी निवासियों को प्राथमिकता प्रदान की जायेगी ।

अतः इस सम्बन्ध में मुझे यह कहने का निर्देश हुआ है, कि कृपया राज्य हित में उपरोक्त सभी बिन्दुओं पर अपनी सहमति शीघ्र अधोहस्ताक्षरी को उपलब्ध कराने का कष्ट करें ।

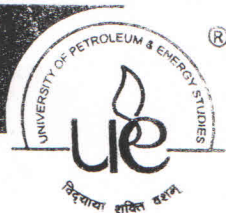

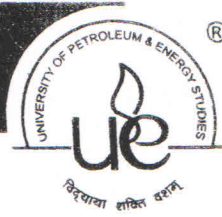
Dear Madam,

We acknowledge the receipt of your Letter No. 45/XXIV (6)2010 dated May 26, 2010 on the subject cited above. On going through the contents, our views are as under:-----

- (1) Since the inception UPES has been extending **10%** reservation in all academic programmes for Uttarakhand domiciled candidates. UPES on an average attracts 27 % of Uttarakhand domiciled candidates based on their merit. **UPES has no objection in increasing the reservation to 15 % provided the candidate meets the qualifying requirements stipulated by the University**
- (2) UPES on its own has also been giving 25 % concession on tuition fee (excluding academic services) to State domiciled students, subject to fulfillment of following criteria:
 - i) Candidate possesses valid Uttarakhand domiciled certificate issued by a competent authority.
 - ii) The total annual family income should not exceed Rs 2 lacs.
 - iii) Candidates should have passed Class X and XII examinations from any school located within the State (relaxed for the wards of Uttarakhand domiciled defense personnel).

This policy is based on merit-cum-means of a candidate and to us appears to be more desirable rather than extending fee concession to all others who can afford. You will appreciate that UPES being a self financed University is not entitled to receive any grants from the government and the main source of revenue is the student fees. Hence, extending this concession to all domiciled candidates will adversely impact our finances. **UPES has no objections in granting 25% concession on tuition fee (excluding academic semester) to the domiciled students of the state of the Uttarakhand on the merit cum means basis as mentioned above.**

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- (3) UPES follows the widely accepted practice of out-sourcing grade C & D requirements (like attendants, safai karamcharis, malis, security staff, cooks, drivers, etc.) but from local agencies who hire local candidates. Such arrangement not only facilitates administrative efficiency but increases productivity as well. The total numbers of employees in this grade are 179 out of which 166 hail from the state of Uttarakhand i.e. approximately 90%. **We have no objection in maintaining a minimum of 90% employees from the state of Uttarakhand under this category.**
- (4) For academic staff positions, we are already giving preference to the Uttarakhand domiciled candidates. **We suggest that no quota should be imposed as these are merit based positions and the University should have the freedom to pick up the best talent to meet the academic standards and provide quality education to the students.**

You would kindly appreciate that UPES is already following most of your views. We suggest that the Government takes the interest of the private (self financed) Universities into consideration while taking a final decision on the proposed measures. On our part, we are willing to cooperate in any possible manner.
