Progression Policy:

Progression from Semester I to II to III to IV will be automatic irrespective of SGPA secured for PG Students.

For UG students progression from 1st year to 2nd year, 2nd year to 3rd year and so on provided he/she has minimum Earned Credits as under:

Progression To	Minimum Credit to be earned
II	50% credit of year I
III	60% credit (cumulative) of year I & II
IV	70% credit (cumulative) of year I, II & III
V	80% credit (cumulative) of year I, II, III & IV
VI	80% credit (cumulative) of year I, II, III, IV & V



• Passing Criteria:

- o **For UG students:** Scoring less than 35 absolute marks in individual course either in end semester examination or as composite score shall be awarded as 'F'.
- o **For PG students:** Scoring less than 40 absolute marks in individual course either in end semester examination or as composite score shall be awarded as 'F'

Relative grading system continued with defined threshold for outstanding (O) and minimum (C). Relative grading system was adopted for batch size above 30.
