


UPES-CSR EXTENSION & OUTREACH ACTIVITIES 2014-15

underprivileged children (3-15 years)



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

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

Project 'Samvedna' - is an initiative to provide education, day-care & mid-day meals to children of construction workers engaged in work at the UPES Campus. The initiative also provides for books, stationery, toys & games, clean drinking water & toilet facilities and medical care to the children. The Day School has a trained B.A., N.T.T. qualified full-time Teacher with 2 nos. full-time Matrons to teach & look-after the children while their parents are busy at work. The project was active throughout 2014-15.

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UPES CSR supported rebuilding of the 'Devanshi Public Sports School (DPSS), Nainbagh, Tehri Garhwal' while it was severely damaged in the Kedarnath Flash floods tragedy in June 2013. Since then, UPES CSR provided a financial support of Rs. 30,000/- (Rupees Thirty Thousand Only) per month towards meeting their educational expenses for its students which continued throughout the year 2014-15 as well.
