1	<p>Students of 'UPES CSI Student Chapter' celebrated '<i>Independence Day</i>' 2016 by organising a CSR activity at '<i>Prem Dham Vridha Ashram</i>' 25 Nehru Road, Dehradun. The interactive session with the residents was the main attraction of the event where the residents addressed the students while sharing their life stories. The students too shared jokes & stories with them and arranged a lunch for everybody in the Ashram. Distribution of sweets marked the 70th year celebrations of our independence.</p>	
2		<p>A 'Cleanliness Drive' was carried out in the Prem Nagar area by the students of the '<i>UPES FIPI Student Chapter</i>' in association with the '<i>ISRO's GEOSPATIAL TAGGING App</i>'. The app allowed for tagging location of unauthorized dumping sites in real time. The event took place in two rounds where the first <i>round</i> comprised of locating the garbage dumping sites, taking their pictures and uploading the same with the help of the ISRO's App. The <i>second round</i> comprised of cleaning up streets and collected garbage areas. In all, 568 student volunteers and FIPI SC members participated in the drive. The event sensitized the residents & passer-by on cleanliness matters.</p>

3 *'Green Up'* student club of the *UPES 'Health, Safety & Environment Engineering Department'*, established with a goal of building greener & sustainable developed nation, celebrated 'ATMOSFAIR-III' a student driven environment awareness program on the occasion of 'World Ozone Day on 16 September 2016. Social awareness programs on Depleting Ozone layer, Ozone Day etc. were carried on through mass media platforms viz. *Facebook, Youtube, FM Radio 90.4* and inter-schools event in the campus.

The students also volunteered to educate students of over 25 schools in Dehradun on environment issues and needs.



4 UPES supported *'Last Mile Governance'* through a 3-Day workshop for *'Training in Panchayati Raj System'* in association with the *'Member, Zila Panchayat, Dehradun'* & *'Avatha Foundation, Pune'* for the elected representatives (including the *Gram Pradhans / Deputy Gram Pradhans / Ward Members*) of the villages located in the vicinity of UPES campuses to fill the gaps in understanding of their rights, duties and entitlements under the *'Panchayati Raj Governance System'*. The participants were exposed to various Central & State Government schemes through which their respective region/area could benefit.

5 Students of *'UPES ACM Student Chapter'* CSR team visited the slums near *Nanda-Ki-Chowki Dehradun* on a *'Teaching Drive'* on 16 October 2016. The drive involved teaching basics to the needy ones along with distribution of special goodies among them. Stationary items viz. notebooks, pencils etc. were distributed among the children as part of the activity. The children enjoyed chips, juice and various refreshments provided by the UPES Team.

A little love & care can light up the saddest of hearts and the members of 'UPES FIPI Student Chapter' proved this by organizing a Clothes Donation Drive from 13 to 21 October 2016. The drive aimed to provide the "KOSHISH" orphanage children with proper clothing in view of the approaching winters. A good quantity of clothes were collected and sent to the orphanage along with other donations such as stationery, money etc.

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A 'Road Safety Awareness' drive was organized by the members of 'UPES FIPI Student Chapter' in the villages adjoining the University on 24 August & 2 October, 2016. The event aimed at spreading awareness of basic road safety rules to save lives. The focus area of the event was from Prem Nagar to UPES Bidholi campus. Besides the local community members, the student volunteers undertook to aware the students of several colleges & universities situated in the region to ensure that they could pass on the message of 'keeping safe on the roads' to their friends & family too. The event witnessed a large-scale participation of 483 student volunteers and included many of the faculty too.



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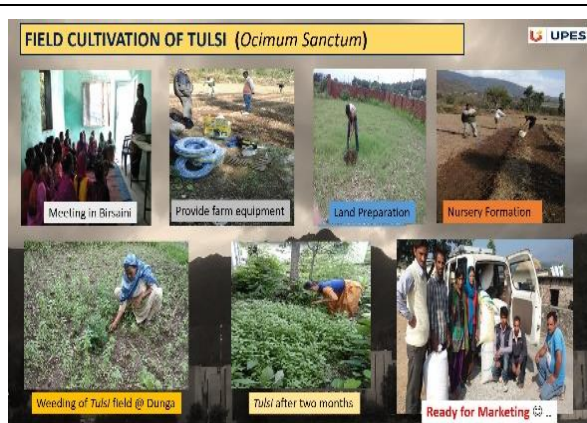


UPES CSR supported 'Running of Free Medical Mobile Van' to provide doorstep medical facilities to the residents of nearby villages in 2016-17 as well. The van equipped with a qualified doctor & a compounder were supported by UPES student volunteers to counsel the patients on how to take the medicines and ensure that all the precautions, as advised by the doctor, are clear to the patients.

UPES-CSR continued skilling Women towards their Economic Empowerment through the 'Rural Women Technology Park' project supported & catalysed by the Department of Science & Technology (DST), Govt. of India in the year 2016-17 as well. The project catered to three components (i) Paper Recycling (ii) ICT Assisted Art & Craft Design & (iii) Identification & Cultivation of Medicinal & Aromatic Plant Species in project area of Sahaspur Block, Dehradun.

Under the first component, rural women of indigenous community were enabled to earn a fair wage by teaching them how to make high-quality goods using waste paper viz. paper pencils, jewellery, stationery items etc. Under the second component, art & craft trainings facility under the supervision of expert artisans in ICT Laboratory with 10 computer systems, installed design software and 24*7 internet. Collaboration with Uttarakhand Bamboo & Fibre Development Board (UBFDB) provided further training & market support to support the beneficiaries. Under the third component, *Stevia*, *Chamomile (tea)*, *Tulsi*, *Ashwagandha*, *Sarpagandha*, *Lemon Grass*, *Aloe Vera* and *Kaliyari* were cultivated by rural women who were sensitized in Promotion & Awareness towards these medicinal & aromatic plants; Diversification of agriculture to make small & marginal holdings more profitable; Developing Individual & Group Entrepreneurship by formation of 'Self Help Group'.

UPES CSR supported rebuilding of the 'Devanshi Public Sports School (DPSS), Nainbagh, Tehri Garhwal' in June 2013.
