

Further, when all games completed the whole area was converted to a live concert where everyone was dancing along with the IEEE team on various songs. In 2017, the IV Tournament of this series was organized in the memory of *Shaheed Hawaldar Narender Singh Bisht* of **4**th **Garhwal Rifles.** Havaldar Bisht laid down his life while fighting the insurgents at 'URI - Kashmir valley' in August 2017.





UPES-CSR launched a new initiative 'Skill Development Programme' for Dehradun Jail Inmates in 'Computer Hardware & Networking Training' under its CSR activities between May & October 2017 for benefitting the educated inmates of the Dehradun District Jail.

The initiative aimed at skilling the inmates through a Computer Technology Training program wherein 25 inmates were shortlisted & selected for a '90-Hour Training Program' spread over four months inside the jail premises. A Govt. of India approved training agency 'CETPA' was contracted for imparting & evaluating the training to ensure that the participants are provided with a certificate on completion of their training. All the participants completed their training successfully. Twelve (12) UPES student volunteers monitored the training process to ensure achievement of desired results.

The objective of this skilling program was to augment the livelihood options of the inmates during the service of their respective sentences and after their release. 'UPES-CSR organized its annual Voluntary Blood Donation Camp in association with the 'Indian Medical Association - Blood Bank' & 'Shri Mahant Indresh Hospital Trust - Blood Bank' as the beneficiaries from 16 to 20 April 2018 at the Kandoli & Bidholi Campuses of UPES.

The 5 Day long Camp was supported by the 'UPES-NSS' (the 'National Service Scheme' has been in operation in UPES since February 2018) and organized in collaboration with the DSDS (Department of Student Development), UPES. 3768 UPES Students contributed their services in administration, registration process, donation & issuing of Donation Certificates to the donors during the 5 days of the camp.

The 'Voluntary Blood Donation Camp' recorded a collection of 1858 Units of blood while 2516 voluntary donors came forward to donate. UPES students, staff & faculty has been a regular blood donors for the past several years.

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

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

The UPES students volunteers provide the to & fro transport support for delivering/pick-up of the Speaker Set to/from the requisitioning school The schools are now able to conduct their functions, national festivities viz. Republic Day; Independence Day, Extra-curricular Activities etc. facilitated by the new 'Audio System'.

The UPES American Society of Safety Engineers (ASSE) organized the 'World Environment Day' celebration in collaboration with department of Health, Safety & Environment on 5th June 2018. Teaching, non-teaching staff, students & Housekeeping of UPES and many guest visitors were part of the celebration.

This year India officially hosted the world environment day 2018 and the theme of the celebration was beat Plastic Pollution. The theme focused on curbing plastic pollution and reducing the usage of single use plastics and act as a catalyst for change The session covered the magnitude and impact of plastic pollution on eco system, practical measures one can adopt to mitigate the problem and campus waste management procedures. 16 student volunteers contributed to the screening of 'Awareness Videos on Plastic Pollution' besides an interactive session on environmental issues in campus and nearby villages. The project provides a free of cost & effective coaching in Physics, Chemistry & Maths for 'JEE' to Engineering aspirants' students of Govt. schools from far-flung Garhwal villages with free boarding/ lodging as well. In 2018 too, *Project Abhilasha* was organized at the UPES Kandoli Campus from 15 to 30 June 2018. Over 900 UPES student volunteers contribute their voluntary services turn-wise to look after the young visiting students in their stay, studies, excursions, games & personality development activities. Every year, the 'Directorate of Education', Govt. of Uttarakhand assists UPES by providing the details of the eligible students for the camp.

The Block Education Officers of all 13 Districts of the state then provide details of the meritorious students who have secured 75% or more in their Class X examinations and are currently in class XII pursuing science stream (with Physics, Chemistry & Maths as essential subjects). The list is then prepared on merit-base. The candidates are then individually contacted for verification of their details and his/her willingness to attend the camp and their parents are spoken with to confirm their assent for sending their children for the camp. A final list is then prepared and the camp schedule is finalised. In 2018, 56 meritorious students from the Govt. Schools attended the Camp under 'Project Abhilasha'.

A group of 46 UPES student volunteers assisted this intervention during July & August 2017. The intervention was discontinued after August due to non-availability of a dedicated medical practitioner.

13 Students of the 'UPES ACM Student Chapter' contributed a step further towards UPES societal responsibility activities by celebrating Christmas season with a learning experience for the 3rd - 5th Grade Students at 'Anmol Educational and Welfare Society, Chhatarpur, New Delhi' on 25.12.17.

For the first time in the History of CSR at UPES ACM & ACM-W Student Chapters, the boundaries of responsible work for Society were challenged by a student chapter; the Chapter came out of the Welfare Network & Eco-System, not only in Dehradun, but of the state 'Uttarakhand too' - "We're Here, New Delhi". Celebrating this merry occasion in the most wonderful way with a lot of fun Activities for the students at 'ANMOL', the volunteers planned some enriching exercises for the students that educated taught them the fundamentals of Computational Thinking & How to create Effective Solutions through activities appropriate to their classroom courses. 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

A group of 392 UPES student volunteers carried out this initiative actively at the Govt. Primary School, Paundha throughout 2017-18.

UPES-CSR continued skilling Women towards their Economic Empowerment through the 'Rural Women Technology Park' project supported & catalysed by the Department of Science & Technology (DST), Govt. of India in the year 2017-18 as well. The project catered to three components (i) Paper Recycling (ii) ICT Assisted Art & Craft Design & (iii) Identification & Cultivation of Medicinal & Aromatic Plant Species in project area of Sahaspur Block, Dehradun district (Uttarakhand). A group of 379 passionate UPES student volunteers contributed to this women empowerment initiative throughout the year 2017-18.

Under the first component, rural women of indigenous community from 15 villages in the project area were enabled to earn a fair wage by teaching them how to make high-quality goods using waste paper viz. woodless - paper pencils, jewellery, stationery items etc.

Under the second component, art & craft trainings facility under the supervision of expert artisans in ICT Laboratory with 10 computer systems, installed design software and 24*7 internet was made available to the rural women (from 8 villages in the project area) so far, empowering them to earn befitting income generating opportunities. Collaboration with Uttarakhand Bamboo & Fibre Development Board (UBFDB) provided further training & market support to support the beneficiaries. The idea was to develop support structure for capacity development and enriched market opportunities.

Under the third component, Stevia, Chamomile (tea), Tulsi, Ashwagandha, Sarpagandha, Lemon Grass, Aloe Vera and Kaliyari were cultivated by rural women who were sensitized in Promo2tion & Awareness towards these medicinal & aromatic plants; Diversification of agriculture to make small & marginal holdings more profitable; Developing Individual & Group Entrepreneurship by formation of 'Self Help Group' and Empowerment of Women through training & participation in the income generating activities.

Operating on the principles of 'self-sustenance', this 18-year-old *Gurukul* is currently home to over 110 meritorious students pursuing their Vedic studies from all parts of the country. Besides their rigorous education curriculum, the Students at *Gurukul* were also exposed to various sporting activities as well.

A UPES-CSR student volunteers team of 211 students took turns to provide a regular academic intervention to the *Gurukul* as technology support of equipping their students with IT skills through its team of Student Volunteers during the year. The Student Volunteers helped the *Gurukul* Students in covering the complete syllabus of their subject of 'Computer Studies' besides imparting basic computer operational skills to their teachers as well.





Project 'Samvedna' - is an initiative to provide education, day-care & mid-day meals to children of construction workers engaged in work at the UPES Campus.

The initiative also provides for books, stationery, toys & games, clean drinking water & toilet facilities and medical care to the children. The Day School has a trained B.A., N.T.T. qualified full-time Teacher with 2 nos. full-time Matrons to teach & look-after the children while their parents are busy at work. The project was active throughout 2017-18 at the Bidholi campus of the University. A team of 224 UPES student volunteers took turns to monitor this initiative compassionately throughout 2017-18 at the Bidholi campus of the University.



'UPES CSR Team carries out an academic intervention under 'Project Vridhi' throughout the year at the 08 Rajkiye Prathamik Vidyalaya's (RPV) located around a radious of 10 Kms of its campuses.

Observing a need for stationery requirements at the schools during the academic sessions, UPES-CSR took upon itself the responsibility of providing Stationery Items viz. Notebooks for English, Maths & Hindi; Pencils; Eraser & Sharpners to the students of RPV BAKARNA through 18 UPES-CSR student volunteers throughout the academic year 2017-18.

The 'PYDS Academy of Learning' at Purkal Village, Bhagwantpur, Dehradun was established in 2008 and is sponsored by the 'Purkal Youth Development Society' - a society committed to provide a nurturing, care-giving environment to empower children from impoverished families of Uttarakhand with promise & potential to carve a path out of poverty for themselves, their families, as well as their communities. PYDS supports its students through the crucial years of their schooling by providing them with a free of cost education, boarding, nutrition, healthcare, etc. The credit for this goes to **Dr. GK Swamy** – Founder, Purkal Youth Development Society'.

In January 2018, Dr. Swamy approached UPES with a request to consider admitting their meritorious students in a program of their choice under concessional fee category. He was concerned as the students of his school, though academically meritorious, had little or no options after passing out from 'PYDS Academy of Learning' due to their families financial limitations.

A visit to PYDS by the Vice Chancellor UPES, where he met five (05) PYDS students who were keen to study at UPES, confirmed Dr. Swamy's claims and the interested PYDS students then appeared for the 'UPES Entrance Examinations' which they passed with good scores. Impressed with the student's academic competence, UPES-CSR launched its pioneering initiative, 'PROJECT PROTSAHAAN' for lending support to all the 05 underprivileged meritorious students of PYDS Academy of Learning. The entire educational expenses for these students have been waived-off which cumulatively amounts approximately Rs. 15 Lakhs annually for pursuing higher education programs in UPES (4 in Technology & 1 in Management Programs). The support further extended to a free of cost set of Uniforms & personal Laptops arranged by the University. Going an extra mile, UPES even arranged for their hostel accommodations at an incredible discount of 50% of the annual charges for the first year and ZERO cost for the balance years.
